

Competitions regulations:

1. Format of the Tournament:

Recreational division:

Four pools of three teams. The teams in each pool are playing single round robin.

First teams of each pool will play play off games for final standing (1st – 4th place).

Second teams of each pool will play play off games for final standing (5th – 8th place).

Third teams of each pool will play play off games for final standing (9th – 12^{ve} place).

Sport division:

Two pools of three teams. The teams in both pools are playing single round robin.

First two teams of both pools will play play off games for final standing (1st – 4th place).

Third teams of both pools will play the game for 5th place.

2. Ties:

Tie is possible in round robin games. Extra inning will be played in play off games.

3. To determine ranking in the groups:

With two teams tied on wins / losses, rank them by the results of their game in the round robin. The winner is placed ahead of the loser.

If still tied – by their runs against record in all the round robin games.

With more than two teams tied on wins / losses, rank them in order:

- By the results of their games among themselves in the round robin games
- By the runs against record in the games among themselves (the team with the lowest runs against is placed ahead of others...)

If any teams tied by the runs against record in the games among themselves:

- By the results of their games among themselves in the round robin games
- By the runs against record in the all round robin games

If any teams tied by the runs against:

- By random selection

4. To determine home / visitors team:

Home is written first in all of the games.
